Submission deadline

The closing date for entries is midnight on **21st April 2023**.

Tips

Answer the category questions as directly as you can. Entries should be in English, please.

Metrics. If you are able to include metrics to demonstrate your case, these give the judges the full picture of your entry's progress. The Global EdTech Awards does recognise, however, that such information may be confidential in the case of edtech companies.

Evidence. Providing evidence of impact is always beneficial in illustrating your case. Please include all that you can.

Technical details. You don't need to outline lots of technical details for EdTech entries, but you do need to provide a comprehensive description of features, functions, and results.

Testimonials. Providing independent testimonials to confirm the nature of your project is always beneficial. The number required is stated in each category.

Confidentiality. All entry information is confidential in that we do not share it with other people or organisations, but some may be mentioned in the awards ceremony should you become a finalist or winner. Therefore, please mark anything you would not want mentioned in this way as 'Confidential' in your entry.

Multiple entries. If you wish to enter more than one category, please do! Simply submit separate entries for each one.

Please note that if the Global EdTech Awards judges feel that your entry would be better suited to a different category than the one you originally entered, they will move it to give you the best chance of success.
